AUDITION DATES: Saturday May 16 & Sunday May 17

AUDITION VENUE: Elder Conservatorium of Music, University of Adelaide

Strings; Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass

Wind: Piccolo/Flute, Bb/A/Alto/Bass Clarinets, Alto/Tenor/Bari Saxophones, Oboe /Cor Anglais, Bassoon/Contra

Brass: Trumpet/Cornet, Horn, Tenor/Bass Trombones, Tenor Horn/Euphonium, Tuba

Percussion: Drum kit, Timpani, Snare drum, Mallet instruments

Country applicants must submit an audio-visual recording

Country applicants submit their recorded audition either in digital format or by posting a DVD or USB to the Camp Administrator. Recordings MUST BE AUDIO-VISUAL and are due **Friday May 15**.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must prepare the following

- ♪ Excerpts provided by SASMC (available to download at the start of Term 2)
- ♪ One own-choice piece (no accompanist)
- ♪ Scales: One major & one minor scale to reflect personal level of playing
- ♪ Metro players will be given sight-reading at the audition (NB. Country applicants will not be disadvantaged for the inability to complete the sight-reading component)

All applicants are notified the outcome of their audition by May 25.

MUSIC CAMP FEES

A **\$30 audition fee per instrument** is payable upon application by cheque, money order or direct bank transfer.

Camp fees cover specialised tuition for the week at camp and are payable upon acceptance. Please note students provide their own morning tea & lunch.

Single player: \$220 **Two players** from one family: \$380 **Three players** from one family: \$570

A limited number of bursaries are available for genuine financial hardship or towards costs for remote rural students. Families may indicate eligibility during the application process.
